Please follow these simple steps:



Bring gifts for your loved ones.



Wear the PPE provided and follow our instructions.



Bring your own refreshments as we will not be able to provide them.

Retain social distancing of 2 metres apart, even if you are wearing PPE.

You will be asked to consent to a test and screening check at every visit via a Visitor's Agreement form. This outlines the visitation process and the guidelines we will ask you to follow. You will also be provided with a copy of our 'Visitor's Policy during COVID-19 Pandemic' which provides information on the processes we have put in place to enable the visits to go ahead whilst mitigating any risk to yourself or our residents.

Non-perishable gifts that cannot be sanitised will be quarantined for 72 hours.
